- Why strengthening the regional cooperation?
- → According to international instruments, the main mechanism for organizing cooperative management is through international bodies such as RFABs/RFMOs
- → Fisheries global issues must/can be addressed at regional level and requires coordination in response to country needs
- → **M**ain international processes (UNGA, CBD, WTO, BBNJ process) are evidencing the need of RFABs/RFMOs role
- → RSN and its members are recognized as key actors in regional cooperation for Countries to deliver Agenda2030
- → RSN and its members positioned in international processes and agendas generate/increase political will and commitment at country level



- → Raising the profile and amplifying regional actors and cooperation in the global arena
















vi. Technical study for future capacity building program: Conservation and management - fisheries and stocks (cont.)

Adoption of conservation and management measures


