### **COOPERATING NON-MEMBERS**

At its 100<sup>th</sup> meeting held from 1 to 5 August 2023 in Phoenix, Arizona, the IATTC renewed the Cooperating Non-Member status of Bolivia, Chile, Honduras, Indonesia, and Liberia.

In accordance with the procedures and deadlines established in Resolution  $\underline{C-07-02}$ , the Director sent letters to the five Cooperating Non-Members, and received the following requests for renewal of that status, which were duly circulated at the dates and with the memorandums indicated in the table below:
