**Annual Report on Sharks and Mobulid Rays 2025 - Vanuatu**

In accordance with of Resolution C 23-07, C 11-10, C 15-04, C-23-07 and C-23-08 this report provides an update on the activities of Vanuatu's flag vessels for 2025 on Sharks and Mobulid rays;

**C-23-07 (Sharks CMM, para 20)**

1. Since all sharks caught in the EPO by Vanuatu flagged fishing vessels are bycatch, Vanuatu reports these bycatch data of sharks by species as below:

**C-11-10 (Oceanic Whitetip Sharks CMM, para 3)**

Based on the 2025 Observer reports, there no Oceanic Whitetip sharks interaction reported by the observer program and no interactions with the Oceanic Whitetip sharks recorded in logsheet.

**C-15-04 (Mobulid Rays CMM, para 4)**

There was no Mobulid Rays interaction data from the observer program in 2025.

**C-23-07 (Management of Shark Species, para 2)**

Vanuatu has no purse seiners operating in the IATTC, therefore are no data to submit.

**C-23-08 (Silky Shark CMM, para 11)**

Vanuatu prohibits its vessels from retaining onboard silky sharks, therefore, Vanuatu does not need to notify the Director regarding the single period of restricted use of steel leaders.
