Many RFMOs have initiatives to support members with capacity challenges

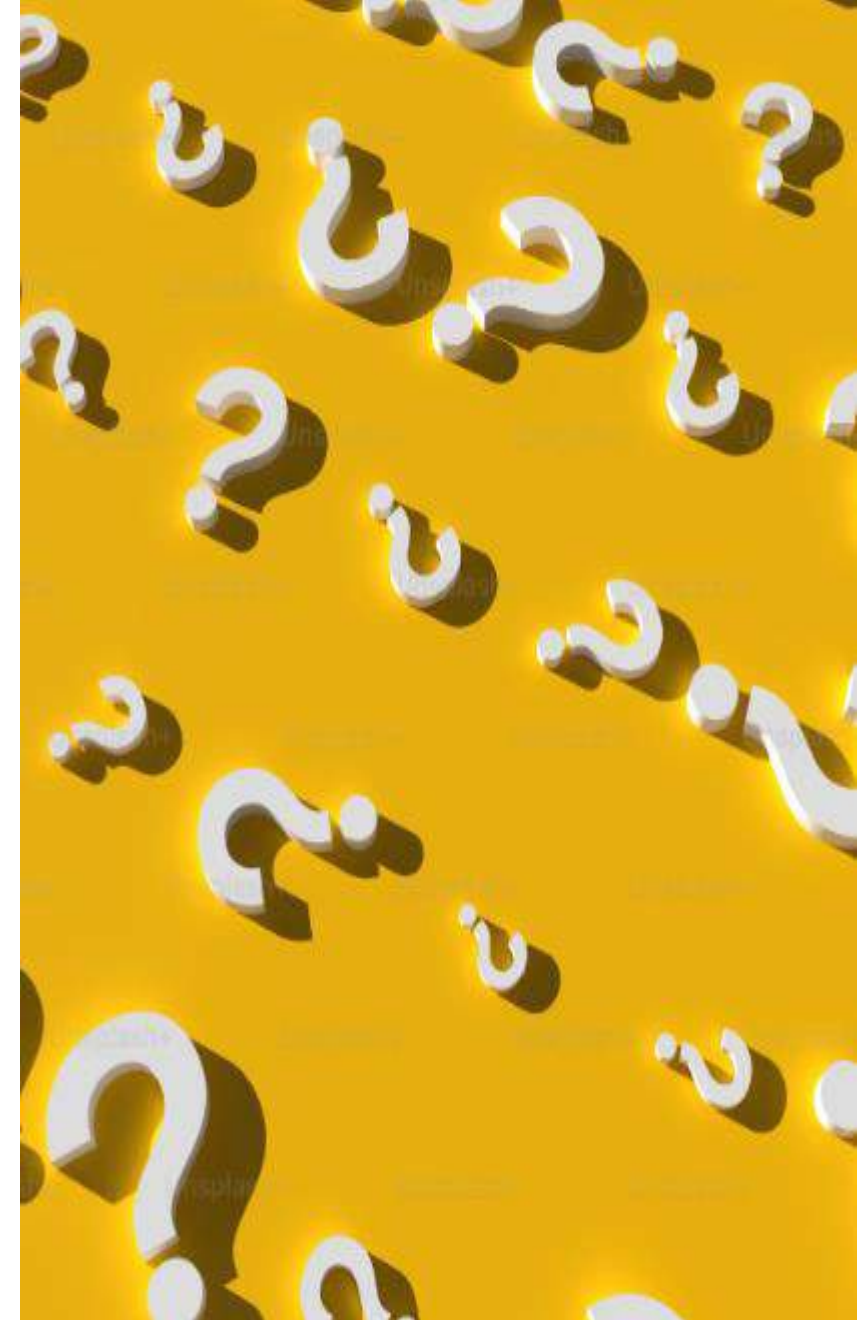
# Purpose of the Capacity Self-Assessment Tool?

Is beneficial for **auditing** and **enhancing systems**, tools, and processes for engaging in RFMO compliance assessment processes.



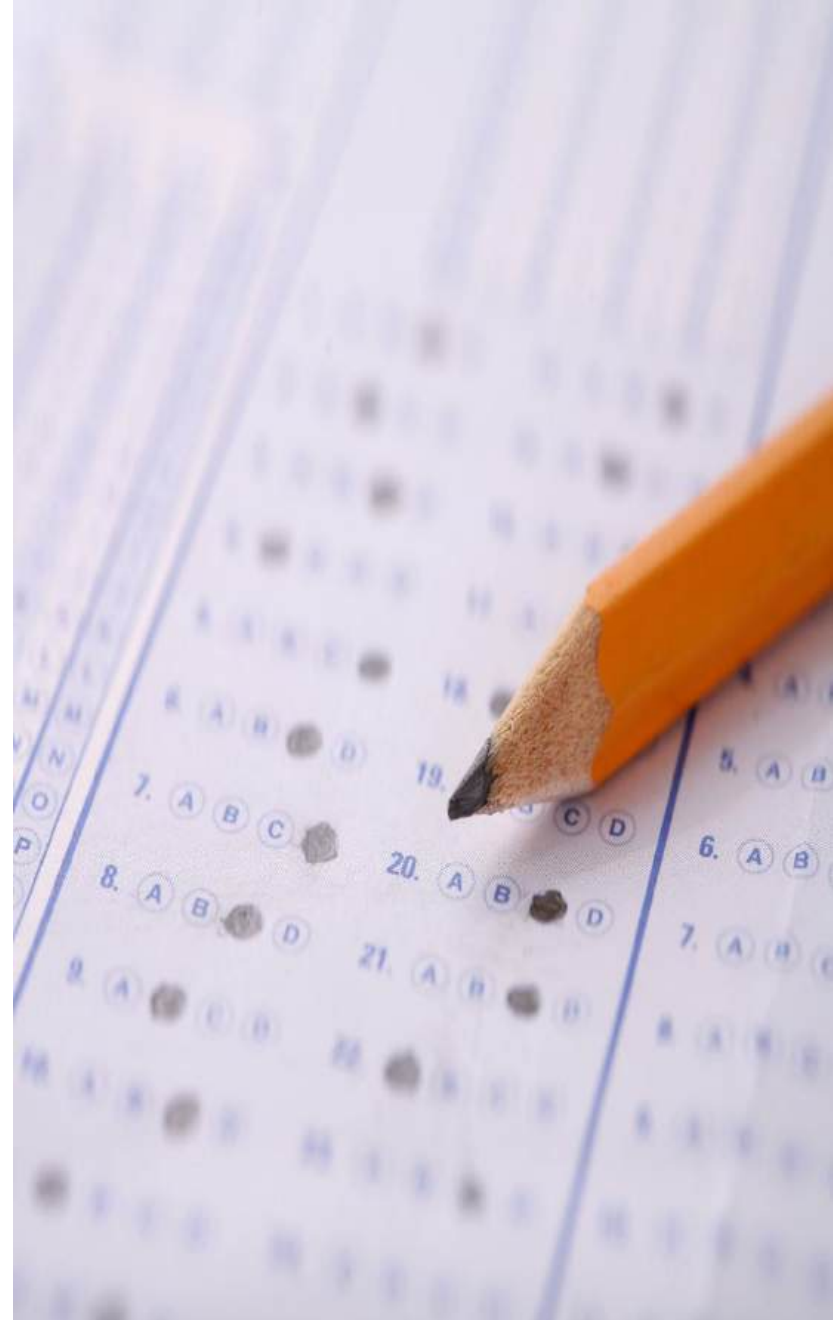
# Who is the Capacity Self-Assessment Tool for?

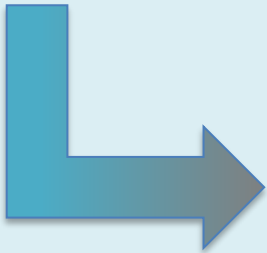

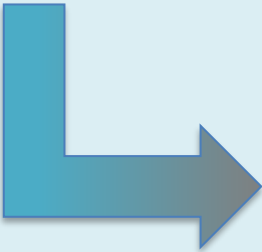

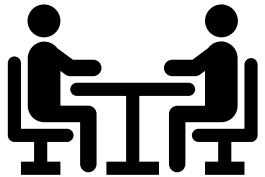
