**COOPERATING NON-MEMBERS**

At its 102<sup>nd</sup> meeting held from 2 to 6 September 2024 in Panama City, Panama, the IATTC renewed the Cooperating Non-Member status of Bolivia, Chile, Honduras, Indonesia, and Liberia.

In accordance with the procedures and deadlines established in Resolution [C-07-02](#), the Director sent letters to the five Cooperating Non-Members, and received the following requests for renewal of that status, which were duly circulated at the dates and with the memorandums indicated in the table below:
