COOPERATING NON-MEMBERS

At its 102^{nd} meeting held from 2 to 6 September 2024 in Panama City, Panama, the IATTC renewed the Cooperating Non-Member status of Bolivia, Chile, Honduras, Indonesia, and Liberia.
