#### IATTC IUU VESSEL LIST

IATTC <u>Resolution C-05-07</u> requires the establishment of a list of vessels presumed to have carried out illegal, unreported and unregulated (IUU) fishing activities in the eastern Pacific Ocean, based on information collected by CPCs and obtained from any other relevant sources.

The procedure for compiling the List is as follows:

- 1. Members transmit to the Director, before 1 February, a list of any vessel presumed to have carried out IUU fishing activities in the EPO during the current and previous years, together with supporting evidence:
- 2. On the basis of this information, the Director prepares a draft IATTC IUU Vessel List and circulates it, with the supporting evidence, to members and to non-Parties with vessels on the List, before 1 March. Before 15 April, comments on the draft List are to be transmitted to the Director;
- 3. The Director prepares a provisional IATTC IUU Vessel List, and transmits it, with the supporting evidence, to the members and the non-Parties concerned, two weeks in advance of the Annual Meeting of the Commission.

Resolution C-05-07 establishes, inter alia, that:

1. The Joint Working Group shall each year examine the provisional IATTC IUU Vessel List, as well as any relevant information provided by CPCs.

The Joint Working Group shall remove a vessel from the provisional IATTC IUU Vessel List if the vessel's flag State demonstrates that:

- a. The vessel did not engage in any of the IUU fishing activities described in paragraph 1 of the Resolution, or
- b. Effective action has been taken in response to the IUU fishing activities in question, including, *inter alia*, prosecution, and imposition of sanctions of adequate severity.
- 2. Following the examination referred to in the above paragraph, the Joint Working Group shall recommend that the Commission approve the provisional IATTC IUU Vessel List, as amended by the Joint Working Group.

The Secretariat transmitted to the relevant governments the draft IUU Vessel List dated 26 February 2010, and the provisional IUU Vessel List dated 10 September, 2010.

The provisional (Appendix A) and current (Appendix B) IATTC IUU Vessel Lists are attached.
