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**TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE TO DEVELOPING COUNTRIES**

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**1. INTRODUCTION**

The purpose of this document is to inform the Administration and Finance Committee (CAF) about the technical assistance and capacity-building activities for developing countries that have been carried out or are planned to be carried out using resources from the Special Fund initially established by Resolution C-11-11. It should be recalled that, at its 82<sup>nd</sup> Meeting in July 2011, the Commission approved, through Resolution [C-11-11](#), the creation of a “*Special fund for strengthening the institutional capacity of developing countries and territories for the sustainable development of fisheries for highly migratory species*”.

At its 87th Meeting, held in July 2014, the Commission introduced a major change to the Fund's financing mechanism. While maintaining the possibility of receiving voluntary contributions—on which the Fund had exclusively relied until that time—the Fund began to receive an annual allocation equivalent to 2% of the Commission's operating budget in accordance with the provisions of Resolution C-14-03.

Paragraph 2 of the aforementioned Resolution establishes that:

*“The resources of the Fund shall proceed from the **fixed annual contribution of 2%** of the Commission's budget intended for building and strengthening the capacity of coastal developing countries and territories.”*

Subsequently, at its 89th Meeting, held in June 2015, the Commission established the specific manner in which this contribution would be distributed among the Members:

*“This 2% is not to be extracted from the operational budget. Rather, once the amount of the operational budget is settled, an additional amount equal to 2% of the operational subtotal shall be added to the regular budget as a separate line item, and the final budget amount will be the sum of these two components, and each Member's contribution to the 2% shall follow therefore the same distribution key as the regular budget.”*

Although paragraph 6 of the Resolution also encourages Members and national and international bodies and entities to make voluntary contributions to the Fund, in practice this source of funding has provided very limited support. Since 2014, no additional voluntary contributions have been received, with the exception of the contribution made by one Member in that same year.

## 2. CURRENT SITUATION OF THE FUND'S FINANCIAL RESOURCES

As described above, the Fund is an integral part of the Commission's regular budget, and contributions to the Fund are included in the annual contribution payable by each Member, in the amount established in the financing resolution currently in force, namely Resolution C-25-10 (Financing for fiscal year 2026).

Consequently, without taking into account possible voluntary contributions, only two factors may affect the availability of the Fund's financial resources: the total amount of the operational budget adopted for a given year and the timeliness with which members comply with their obligation to pay their annual contributions.

In this context, **Table 1** presents the Fund's balance for previous years, as well as the payments received through June 30, 2026. It also shows, for illustrative purposes only, the portion of each Member's annual contribution that is automatically allocated to the Fund, in accordance with the provisions of Resolution C-14-03 (Capacity Building). It should be noted that, as an exception and only for fiscal year **2026**, the Commission decided not to allocate budgetary resources to the Special Fund for strengthening the institutional capacities of developing Members, considering that the available resources were sufficient to cover the activities planned for that year.

To date, and over the years, several developing Members of the Commission have benefited from the Fund’s resources. It should be noted that those resources cannot be used for technical assistance and capacity-building for Cooperating Non-Members, as they do not currently contribute to the Fund’s financing.

Although the Fund has been functioning satisfactorily in practice, its optimal use requires—as is the case with other funds of this nature—the development and adoption of appropriate rules, particularly with regard to the criteria and procedures for the efficient planning and implementation of technical assistance and capacity-building activities. For example, with regard to the allocation of support intended to ensure the participation of representatives of eligible Members in the meetings of the Commission and its subsidiary bodies, it would be advisable to clarify aspects such as the procedures and deadlines for submitting requests for support.

The development of those specific rules remains pending, in accordance with the provisions of paragraph 4 of Resolution C-14-03, which states: “*The administration of the Fund shall be the responsibility of the Director and shall be subject to the auditing rules of the Commission and the **financial regulations for the administration of the Fund to be developed by the Commission.***”

### **3. ACTIVITIES PLANNED OR IMPLEMENTED USING FUND RESOURCES DURING 2025 AND 2026**

In accordance with the activities approved by the Commission at its previous meeting, the activities described in Table 3 were planned to be carried out during 2025 and 2026. The table presents the implementation status of each activity, as well as the corresponding updated information.

#### 4. ACTIVITIES SCHEDULED FOR 2027

Resolution C-14-03 states in paragraph 3 that *“The Director shall present to the Commission for its approval every year the strategic investment plan chargeable to the Fund, which shall be constructed on the basis of the requirements of the developing countries and territories and the analyses carried out by the Commission staff.”*

In accordance with this provision, the activities proposed to be financed from the Fund during 2027 are presented below. **Table 4** includes the estimated cost, as well as the planned date and location for each activity.

It should be noted that the activities planned and proposed for 2027 will be financed with resources from the Fund, comprising the fixed annual contribution equivalent to 2% of the Commission's operating budget for that year, as well as the remaining resources from previous years. All proposed activities are consistent with the provisions of Resolution C-14-03.
