ANNOTATED AGENDA

1. Opening of the meeting

Meeting will commence at 9:00 a.m. on 25 August, 2026.

The Chair Mr. Antonio Vásquez, will open the 17th Meeting of the Committee for the Review of Implementation of Measures Adopted by the Commission (COR) and welcome delegations of IATTC Members, Cooperating Non-Members and Observers.

2. Adoption of the agenda

a) Adoption of Provisional Agenda

The Chair will present the “Provisional Agenda” to the Committee for its consideration and adoption. In accordance with the *Rules of Procedure*, any Member may request the inclusion of supplementary items in the provisional agenda at least forty-five (45) days before the date fixed for the opening of the meeting. Such items shall be communicated to the Members at least thirty (30) days before the opening of the meeting (Rule 9). The agenda, as modified, will need to be adopted by the Committee.

The Chair will recall that there are no supplementary agenda items pursuant this procedure.

The Chair will recall that, in addition to the documents before the Committee, paragraph 4 of Resolution C-24-03 calls upon the Committee to review the implementation of the monitoring, control and surveillance measures reported by CPCs. This will be taken up under Item 4, which covers compliance with IATTC measures in 2025.

b) Meeting arrangements

The Committee will review the indicative schedule and consider any logistical arrangements to support the meeting, including proposed meeting times, small working groups and any side events. The Chair will recall that the 2nd Special Biennial Meeting of the Committee will convene on 26 of August, immediately following the close of second day COR-17 meeting, this in accordance with the organization of work communicated to Members.

c) Appointment of rapporteur

In accordance with the *Rules of Procedure*, the Committee shall appoint a rapporteur from one of the Members at the beginning of the meeting to assist the Chair in the production of a meeting report (Rule 10).

3. Recommendations of the Committee

a) Recommendations from the 16th meeting: progress report

The IATTC staff will present Document *COR-17-01a: Recommendations of the 16th meeting of the Committee – progress report*, which provides a summary of the progress made in regards the implementation of the recommendations from COR-16, as adopted by the Commission.

b) Recommendations from previous meetings: follow-up

The IATTC staff will present Document *COR-17-01b: Recommendations from previous meetings – follow up*, which compiles the status of recommendations adopted at earlier meetings of the Committee that remain relevant or pending. The Committee is invited consider the information presented—including the IATTC staff updated status of completion—and provide guidance or further recommendations as it deems appropriate.

4. Compliance with IATTC measures in 2025:

a) Provisional Compliance Overview

The IATTC staff will present Document *COR-17-02: Provisional Compliance Overview*—published on the compliance restricted access section in IATTC website—, which provides a report on compliance with IATTC measures in 2025, in particular regarding the performance of tuna fleets operating in the Eastern Pacific Ocean (EPO), as well as the data submission and reporting obligations established by the IATTC Resolutions.

b) Review of patterns and trends regarding possible non-compliance cases

Pursuant to Recommendation 8 of the 16th meeting of the Committee, and aligned with Element 4 of the *Priority Elements of a draft Work Plan for the COR*, the IATTC staff will present a document identifying thematic areas and Resolutions that warrant particular attention, based on a review of patterns and trends in possible non-compliance cases. The Committee is invited to consider the analysis presented and may identify priority areas for its future work.

c) Review of the questionnaires and additional information submitted by CPCs in compliance with Resolution C-22-02

The Committee will review Document COR-17-02b: “Draft Provisional Compliance Report” prepared by the IATTC staff, that identifies areas of possible non-compliance with IATTC Resolutions. This report is based on the information provided by CPCs in their Annual Questionnaire, observer reports from the IATTC observer programs for purse-seine fishing vessels, at-sea transshipment, and longliners-as well as other available information.

Each CPC identified in the document with a possible non-compliance issue with any given Resolution, will have the opportunity to comment, provide additional information and clarify what actions it has or has not taken in to resolve the issue, and whether or not the CPC seeks a different status on the possible non-compliance issue.

The “Provisional Compliance Report” will be submitted to the Commission for its eventual adoption as the *Final Compliance Report*.

5. Review of unresolved cases of possible non-compliance (2020-2024)

Recommendation 8 of the 15th meeting of the Committee tasked the IATTC staff to systematically include in the *Provisional Compliance Overview* a table with the unresolved cases from the previous five years. Recommendation 17 of the 16th meeting further called for sufficient time to be allocated to this item.

In addition, Element 2. Follow-up of previous infractions of the *Priority elements of a draft Work Plan for the COR* tasked the IATTC staff to add the follow-up of possible infractions from previous years as a standing point on the agenda.

In completing this task, the IATTC staff has developed Document *COR-17-06: Review of unresolved cases of possible non-compliance (2020-2024)*, which contains information on unresolved cases of possible non-compliance from previous years, together with the updates provided by Members in response to the Chair's letters issued pursuant to paragraph 7 of Resolution C-22-02, for the consideration of the Committee.

6. Review of the provisional IUU vessel list

The Committee will review the *Provisional IUU Vessel List* as well as the information that supports the inclusion or removal of vessels in the List, submitted in accordance with Resolution C-19-02.

The Committee will recommend that the Commission approve the *Provisional IATTC IUU Vessel List*, with the amendments agreed there.

In addition, the Committee will recommend the removal or retention of 3(j) vessels from the current IUU Vessel List if suitably documented information is presented in accordance with C-19-02.

7. Cooperating non-Members

The IATTC staff will present Document *COR-17-05: Cooperating Non-Members* which contains relevant information for reviewing requests of Cooperating Non-Members. The Committee will recommend to the Commission whether an applicant should be granted the Cooperating Non-Member status.

8. Other business

This agenda item intends to provide a limited opportunity for the Committee to consider any other relevant issue related to its framework.

9. Election of the Committee's Chair

In accordance with the Rules of Procedure, the Committee will proceed with the election of its Chair for the corresponding term. This agenda item will be conducted by the IATTC Director.

10. Recommendations for the Commission

The Committee will adopt an outcome document that reflects the Recommendations that stemmed from discussions, with a full summary report to be cleared intersessionally and presented to the Commission for its adoption.

11. Adjournment

Members and/or the Chair may want to provide closing remarks, after this the Chair will close the meeting.
