CASES OF POSSIBLE NON-COMPLIANCE WITH THE *OPERATIONAL REQUIREMENTS FOR VESSELS* DESCRIBED IN ANNEX VIII OF THE AIDCP AND OCCURRED SINCE THE 71ST MEETING (AND PREVIOUS CASES NOT REVIEWED YET)

During the period since the 71st meeting of the IRP, the Secretariat has reviewed a total of 211 fishing trips. Of these, we have three trips with cases of possible non-compliance that the IRP identifies at predetermined form; that is, the Secretariat has been instructed by the IRP to forward them to the Parties for investigation after each meeting. In addition, we have one case of possible non-compliance that the IRP requires to analyze and provide guidance to the Secretariat during its meeting.
