RE: Liberia's Application for Cooperating Non-Party Status

Dear Director Compeán, et al.:

In accordance with paragraph 6 of IATTC Resolution C-14-02 on the Establishment of a Vessel Monitoring System (VMS), Liberia provides the following:

- 1. All Liberian flagged carrier vessels (authorized for transshipment operations) are required to install and operate an Iridium satellite-based VMS, designed to provide real-time position reporting, email/messaging, and notification forms via a reporting tablet.
- 2. The VMS unit is provided by the Flag Administration; installation and operational functionality is mandatory before the issuance of any Transshipment License. The VMS consists of a satellite terminal, Bluetooth junction box and thorium tablet. The tablet is capable of transmitting reports and transshipment declarations/data. The VMS data is collected and stored by the land-based Fisheries Monitoring Centre (FMC) of the Flag Administration. The VMS units are tamper-proof and capable of operating continually with backups in place. In the event of a technical failure, the defective VMS unit has to be repaired or replaced within one (1) month. A dispensation must be obtained from the Flag Administration during this period. A Master of a Liberian flagged vessel is prohibited from commencing a transshipment operation with a defective VMS unit. Notwithstanding, a vessel with a defective VMS unit must communicate, at least every 4 hours, reports to the FMC.
- 3. Although capable, the VMS provided to Liberian flagged carrier vessels is currently not transmitting transshipment information electronically to the IATTC. Transshipment data is submitted via email.
- 4. Decide on a format and acceptance criteria for electronic transmission of Transshipment Declarations.
