REVIEW OF DOLPHIN MORTALITY LIMITS (DMLs) FOR 2016¹

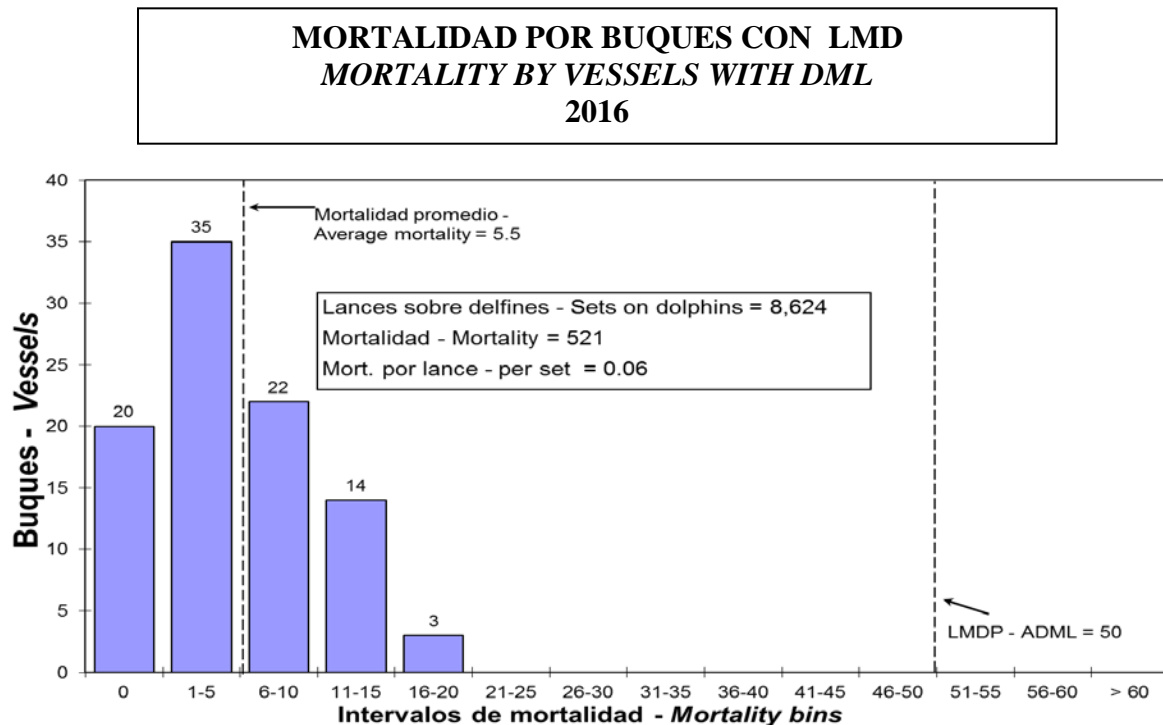
This report presents details about the utilization of Dolphin Mortality Limits (DMLs) in 2016.

The overall limit for the fleet is 5,000, and the portion available for distribution is 4,900; the difference constitutes the Reserve DML Allocation (RDA), utilized at the Director's discretion for extraordinary cases.

The current situation for 2016 is as follows:
