

2nd Joint IATTC-WCPFC NC Working Group Meeting on the Management of PBF-August 2017, Busan, Korea

Recommends that the RFMOs consider incorporating the following in their decision making:

- 1. Recruitment Scenario Used in SSB Projections
 - Through 2024 or until SSB reaches its historical median value-use low recruitment scenario
 - After 2024 or SSB reaches its historical median value use average recruitment scenario from entire time series
 - ISC periodically evaluate this approach
- 2 Management until Reaching the Historical SSB Median
 - Management objective is to rebuild SSB to historical median by 2024 with at least 60% probability
 - Interim HCR should be applied based on stock assessment results and possibly ISC requested SSB projections (increasing catch limits)--PRESENTATIONS

2nd Joint IATTC-WCPFC NC Working Group Meeting on the Management of PBF-August 2017, Busan, Korea

Recommends that the RFMOs consider incorporating the following in their decision making:

- 3 Management After Reaching the Historical SSB Median
 - Management objective is to rebuild SSB to 20%SSB_{F=0} within 10 years after reaching the historical SSB median or by 2034, whichever is earlier, with at least 60% probability
 - ISC regularly conducts stock assessment to assess status
- 4 Management After Reaching 20%SSB_{F=0}
 - Use MSE to guide decision making request to ISC -- PRESENTATION

2nd Joint IATTC-WCPFC NC Working Group Meeting on the Management of PBF-August 2017, Busan, Korea

Recommends that the RFMOs consider incorporating the following in their decision making:

- 5 Emergency Rule Drastic Drops in Recruitment
 - Starting in 2019, periodically request ISC to determine if drops in recruitment are detected
 - If detected ISC conduct projections to determine what additional measures can be applied to rebuild SSB to the initial rebuilding target by 2024
- 6 Catch Documentation Scheme (CDS)
 - Agreed to concept of CDS for further discussion by IATTC and WCPFC
 - Assess utility of electronic reporting
 - Potential basic elements (types of data)
 - Work plan for CDS
- 7 Next Joint Meeting in conjunction with NC14
